The INON **ZD Male Bayonet for SD Lens** is an after service part kit for SD Mount series lens enabling to use for ZD Front Mask

***Not for "UFL-GR140 ZD" for replacing damaged/worn lens mount.**

***Prepare precision screw driver Philipps #0 and interdental brush or alike.**

How to Replace

① Remove the original lens mount

Unscrew 6 x fixing screws by using a Philipps screw driver #0 and separate the original mount and lens barrel.

If you have any difficulty to unscrew fixing screw(s) due to salt-build-up etc, do not proceed any further and consult your purchasing dealer for advice

Should you damage fixing screw(s), the original lens mount may not be separated from the lens. Please consult your purchasing dealer for advice



② Clean screw holes

Clean screw holes on the lens barrel by using an interdental brush or alike.

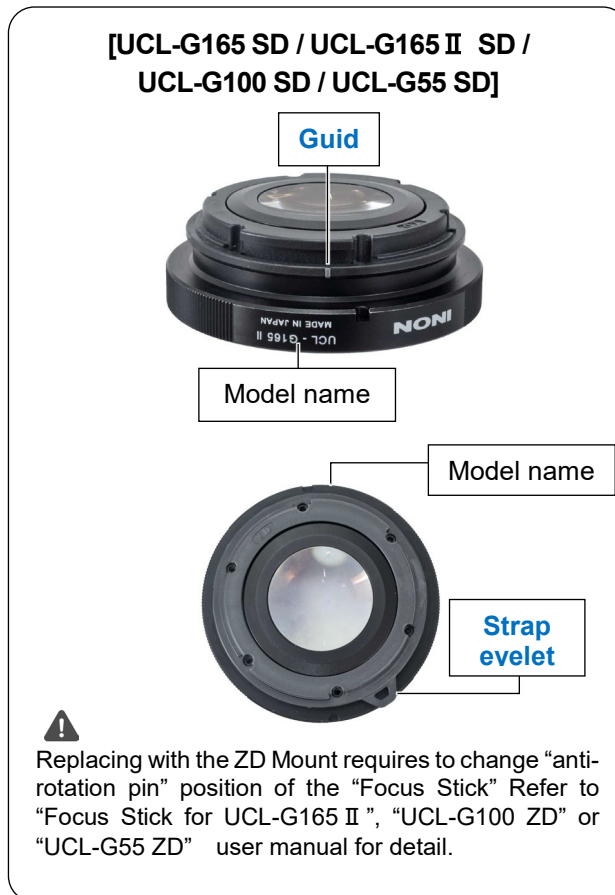
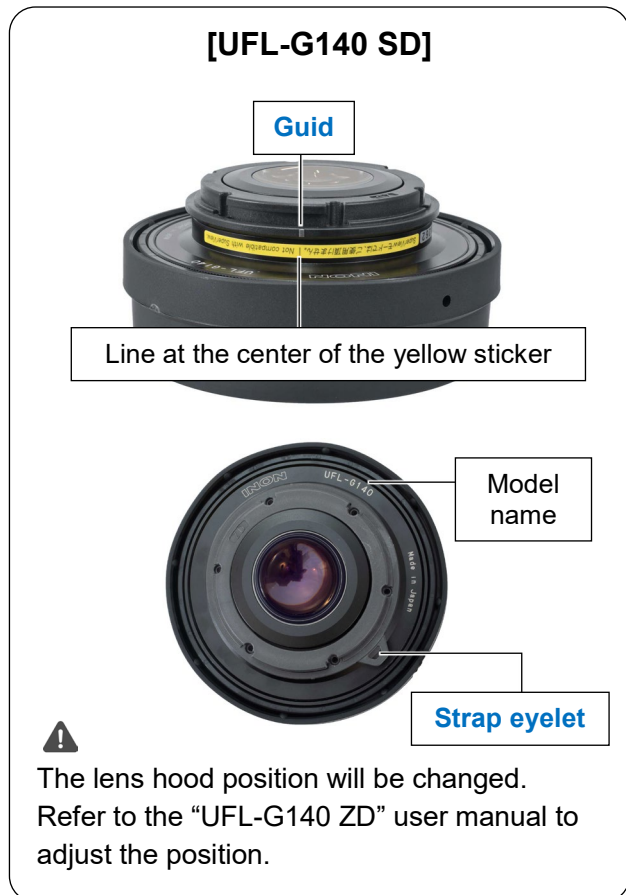


Install the ZD Male Bayonet on the lens barrel!

Align the 6 screw holes on the lens barrel with the 6 holes on the ZD Male Bayonet and fasten using the supplied M2x4 precision screws.



Attach the ZD Male Bayonet so that the relative position of the “guide” and “strap eyelet” are as per below images.



Tighten the M2x4 precision screws evenly using a precision screwdriver with drawing cross pattern not to create uneven tightening. Uneven or over tightening may result in damage to the lens body.

- Please follow above installation method to attach this product and note that you have to take full responsibility for the installation. If you are not confident for proper installation, please consult your purchasing dealer.
